

## 2015 Examples of Anti-Semitic Incidents on University Campuses

- November 22, 2015 University Of Maryland, College Park Anti-Semitic language and a swastika was drawn on three female residents' dry erase board.
- **November 12, 2015: Hunter College:** Students held a "Million Student March" <u>featuring</u> anti-Semitic slogans such as "Zionists Out of CUNY" and "long Live the Intifada." Organized by Students for Justice in Palestine (SJP), the demonstration linked financial concerns to the "Zionist administration."
- October 10, 2015: Townson University: Anti-Semitic phrases including "Hitler was right" and "With Jews you lose" were written on a chalkboard in the middle of campus.
- October 10, 2015: UC Davis: Large swastikas were keyed into the hood of 11 cars, with slurs against Jews etched on at least five cars, and eight tires were slashed at one of the school's parking lots.
- October, 2015: Rutgers University: A pro-Palestinian student leader of the group, Students for
  Justice in Palestine, <u>refused</u> to recognize Israel's right to exist, and claimed Palestinians have the right
  "to exist and resist."
- **September, 2015: Western New Mexico State University:** A man entered the university's Center for Gender Equity and wrote "lewd and hateful" words on a board, including anti-Semitic comments.
- June 19, 2015: Northwestern University: Swastikas and one other Nazi symbol were found written in the dirt on the windows of the school's stadium on the day of commencement.
- June 8, 2015: Northwestern University: Construction workers <u>found</u> anti-Semitic and racist graffiti spray-painted at the construction site of the Kellogg School of Management building.
- May, 2015: Drexel University: A Jewish student <u>found</u> a swastika and the word "Jew" written near an Israeli flag he had on display outside of his dorm room.
- April 25, 2015: Stanford University: <u>Swastikas</u> were painted on the Sigma Alpha Epsilon (SAE) fraternity house, along with personal slurs.
- April, 2015: Framingham State University: A swastika was <u>keyed</u> into a car of a student parked in a campus lot.
- March, 2015: Northeastern University: Swastikas were found drawn on a dry-erase board in a common space area at of one of the school's dormitories.
- March 2, 2015: University of California, Berkeley: the <a href="phrase">phrase</a> "Zion-ists should be sent to the gas cham-ber" was found in a campus restroom.
- **February 10, 2015: UCLA:** Rachel Bedya, a sophomore at UCLA, stood before UCLA's student government (the Undergraduates Students Association Council, or USAC) to apply to become a member of UCLA's Judicial Board. She received some questions that had nothing to do with her qualifications, but her religion. Fabienne Roth, a member of USAC, <u>asked</u> Rachel: "Given that you are a Jewish student and very active in the Jewish community, how do you see yourself being able to maintain an unbiased view?" Rachel was dispatched from the room for 40 minutes, and USAC members discussed whether Rachel's affiliations with Jewish groups (including Hillel and her sorority) would make her biased in dealing with governance issues if she served on UCLA's Judicial Board. USAC first voted to reject Rachel's nomination, and after the prodding of a faculty member, revisited the issue and unanimously put her on the board.
- **February, 2015: The University of Chicago:** the line "Gas them, burn them and dismantle their power structure. Humanity cannot progress with the parasitic Jew" was <u>posted</u> on the University's anonymous social media app, Yik Yak.



- **February, 2015: George Washington University:** Swastikas were <u>found</u> painted on the walls inside a GWU dorm which houses a group of fraternities and sororities.
- January 31, 2015: University of California, Davis: Swastikas were <u>painted</u> on the Alpha Epsilon Pi fraternity house affiliated with the university (located off campus).
